

CJSF

California Junior Scholarship Federation (CJSF) is a club whose purpose is to foster high standards of scholarship, service, citizenship, and appropriate activities on the part of California students in grades seven and eight. The September membership drive is limited to eighth graders. Seventh graders will be eligible to join CJSF after completing their fall semester in January.

Membership in CJSF is determined by grades earned the previous semester. Language Arts, history, mathematics, science, spanish, advanced drama, advanced art, AVID, choir, band and orchestra earn three (3) points for a grade of "A" and one (1) point for a grade of "B". Two (2) points are earned for a grade of "B" in Honors Science and Honors Math. *Physical Education (PE), Academic Assistant, and other electives do not earn points for membership.* A total of ten (10) points are needed for membership each semester. Membership is then granted for the semester following the one in which the qualifying grades were earned.

Students must re-apply each semester.

Applications are available on the ASI webpage and in room 113. Completed applications must be turned in to room 113. Qualifying students will need to:

1. Complete an application
2. Attach a copy of your grades from Student/Parent Connect
3. Pay \$5.00 dues* for each semester you are joining.
