- 1. **Welcome** Principal Omar Hemaidan welcomed everyone. All attendees introduced themselves to the group.
 - a. **Brief overview of IDAC purpose** Principal Hemaidan shared District website for IDAC info and gave a brief history and overview.

 - i. Websites Mrs. Golling shared and demonstrated how to translate any CUSD website into a language other than English.
 - ii. Instant Connect Mrs. Golling also shared that if the home language in "Q" is something other than English, when communication is sent home via email or text, it automatically will translate into the home language.

 - i. Noelle Golling reviewed our new website-based safety program, Catapult. In reviewing, she described the improved efficiency in communication, attendance, and ability to quickly contact students, staff, administration, and local EMS.
