STUDENT CONNECT: COURSE REQUESTS

1. Login to Student Connect and select the Requests tab to register for your classes. This will only be open from February 27th - March 19th.
2. Select **THREE** elective options. Students will be placed in one of their three elective choices or an intervention course by their counselor.
3. Optional: Students wishing to take two electives will need to select Zero Period or Lunch PE. Elective combinations must meet criteria listed under PE Requests.

To take TWO electives and Zero or Lunch Period PE, a student must be enrolled in one of the following combinations:

- Two Performing Arts
- One Performing Art and an Application elective
- One Performing Art and a mandated Intervention course

CAREFULLY READ THE FOLLOWING:

- At least ONE of your elective choices must be a NON-application elective.
- If you select one or more semester course(s), you will be placed in any of the other three semester courses for your second semester. Your second semester course is not guaranteed. If you do not like one of the semester courses, we suggest you choose yearlong electives only.
- Those requiring academic support may be enrolled in Reading, Math or Study Strategies in place of an elective.
- Please note: Class balancing takes place within the first two weeks of the school year. Class schedules may be subject to change.
- NO schedule changes will be made unless you are in the wrong class.
