Guidelines for Earning the Block ASI Award

Overview:

This is the MOST PRESTIGIOUS AWARD a student can earn at Alta Sierra Intermediate. This award gives special recognition to students excelling in the domains of Mind, Body, and Spirit through participation in Scholarship, Co- Curricular, Fitness and Service. This honor is available to ALL students in 7th and 8th grade and is awarded at the end of the school year. The purpose of this award is to recognize those well-rounded individuals who exemplify the qualities that Alta Sierra Intermediate School hopes to foster in all its students: (1) the desire for self-improvement, (2) a dedication and commitment in reaching goals, (3) concern for and service to others, and (4) the willingness to be positive role model to others. We encourage parents to work closely with their students throughout the school year, making it a part of their planning for the total school experience. Whether or not the student receives the award, striving for it will enrich and enhance his/her educational foundation.

Honor Roll- All A's and B's both semesters (Required)

Students may earn a check mark for each semester by attaining all A's and B's.

Destination Imagination (DI) - Mr. Downer, Advisor

Students may earn a "check mark" for participation and completion in the Regional Destination Imagination competition.

Math Counts - Mrs. Nenadov, Advisor

Students may earn a "check mark" for participation in all practices and the CSUF Math Counts competition.

Regional History Day Project Completed - Mrs. Hodge, Advisor

Students may earn a "check mark" for completion and participation in the Regional History Day competition.

Regional Science Fair Project Completed - Mrs. Silva, Coordinator

Students may earn a "check mark" for completion and participation in the Regional Science Fair competition.

Robotics – First Tech Challenge - Mrs. Kirk, Advisor

Students may earn a "check mark" for participating in all practices and the competition.

Robotics – First LEGO League - Miss H. Bishop, Advisor

Students may earn a "check mark" for participating in all practices and the competition.

Science Bowl - Mr. Chilpigan, Advisor

Students may earn a "check mark" for participating in all practices and the competition.

Regional Science Olympiad – Coordinators: Mrs. Chilpigan, Mrs. Harris, and Mrs. Trenhaile

Students may earn a "check mark" for completion and participation in the Regional Science Olympiad competition.

Spelling Bee - Mr. Downer, Advisor

Students may earn a "check mark" for participating in all practices and the competition.

Body - Fitness & Effort

Athletics - Mr. Zimmer, Athletic Director

Students may earn a "check mark" from their coach for participating in a sport this year.

Fall Season: Cross Country, Football, Girls' Golf, Girls' Tennis, Girls' Volleyball, Boys' Water Polo and Girls' Water Polo.

Winter Season: Boys' Basketball, Girls' Basketball, Gymnastics, Boys' Soccer, Girls' Soccer, and Wrestling.

Spring Season: Baseball, Diving, Boys' Golf, Softball, Swimming, Boys' Tennis, Track and Field, and Boys' Volleyball, Badminton

Community Athletics/Dance (If the activity Is not offered at ASI)

Students may earn a "check mark" for participation in a community athletic team or dance class if it is not offered at ASI. A verification form must be completed and attached to the Block ASI Award form to receive the check.

Pep and Cheer - Mrs. Lee, Advisor

Students may earn a "check mark" for participating in all practices and competitions.

Color Guard – Ms. Tucker and Mrs. Balch, Coach

Students may earn a "check mark" if they participate for the entire season.

Spirit - Student Leadership/Community Service

Activities and requirements in this category have to do with character and leadership development. They are designed to provide opportunities for the development of such character attributes as concern for and service to others, active citizenship, civic mindedness, cooperation, responsibility, and dedication.

Bruin of the Month

Students may earn a "check mark" for being selected by one of their teachers for Bruin of the Month for exhibiting one of the character strengths of Positivity Project.

Community Service

Students may earn a "check mark" for performing at least 20 hours of community service each year. Verification of community service must be recorded on the "Community Verification Form". Examples of community service include participation in Boy or Girl Scouting events, church-sponsored service activities, volunteering in an animal shelter or a retirement home, or other activities serving charitable and/or non-profit organizations.

Principal's Advisory for Student Affairs (PASA) - Mrs. Carter, Advisor

Students may earn a "check mark" for serving on the PASA committee. Students will be required to attend lunch time meetings.

Performing Arts Parade/Performance

Students may earn a "check mark" for participating in a Performing Arts Parade or Performance.

Winter Percussion, Mr. Power, Coach

Students may earn a "check mark" if they participate for the entire season.

Run for Student Leadership - Mrs. Martin, Student Body Advisor

Students may earn a "check mark" for running for a Student Body Office. Students are required to follow all guidelines in running for these positions as outlined by the Student Body Advisor.

Art or Writing Contest or Published Article – AB Teacher or Art Teacher

Students may earn a "check mark" for participation in any or all of the several essay or art contests offered throughout the school year. Participation means submitting a completed essay or artwork by the student which is acceptable to the teacher for entry into competition. A copy of the entry and entry form must accompany application. Please check our website for various writing and art contest opportunities throughout the year.

ASI Student Body Drama Production - Mr. Estep, Director

The ASI student Body Drama Production auditions are offered to all 7th and 8th grade students. When cast or accepted into the play crew, students may earn a "check mark" for attending and participating in all practices and performances.

Community Theater Productions – Mr. Estep, Advisor

Students who participate in community theater productions whether as a cast member or in the production crew may earn a check mark for attending and participating in all required rehearsals and performances.

Honor Group (Music) - Mr. Charnow, Band; Mrs. Watson, Choir; Mr. Fredrickson, Jazz; or Mr. Neuenschwander, Orchestra; or Mr. Power, Percussion

Students may earn a "check mark" for participating in all practices, competitions and performances for Honors Band, Honors Choir, Honors Jazz or Honors Orchestra.

Film Festival Entry - Mr. Downer, Advisor

Students may earn a "check mark" for participating in a Film Festival. Participation means submitting a completed short film by the student which is acceptable to the teacher for entry into competition. Please check our website for various Film Festival opportunities this year.

Additional Club Participation – Club Advisors

A check mark may be earned by students who voluntarily attend meetings on a regular basis during lunch or after school of an ASI designated club such as, Campus Life, F.C.A. Hispanic, Asian, or African American Leadership, H.R.C. or G.S.A. These meetings must happen outside of the regularly scheduled monthly club meetings.

Procedures for Block ASI Verification

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1. Student will complete the Block ASI application.
2. Student will check off the activities/items they have earned and acquire appropriate initials/signatures.
3. Student will complete and return the "Community Service Verification Form" (If applicable with the appropriate signature). Members of a student's family **may not** sign the "Community Service Verification Form".
4. Student will obtain initials from all advisors/coaches where required.
5. Student will turn in their form(s) to the Kodiak Cluster Office by the specified date and time which can be found on the Block ASI Timeline, school website, and daily announcements during the month of May.
